These machines can be collected anytime beforehand.

Accommodation at youth hostels will be as Friday in Wales as in 1x block booking after that individual.

There won't be a service vehicle following, but any mechanical issue can be dealt with amongst those attending . If not able to find a solution the individual's recovery should be used.
